

UNIFORMS

SCHOOL UNIFORMS:

PLEASE NOTE – change in uniform Turtle neck tee shirts are no longer permitted.

Students in Grades One through Eight wear the school uniform during the entire school year, beginning with the first day of school. Scout uniforms may be worn instead of the school uniform on the day of the Scout Meeting. Any other exceptions will be communicated by the Principal in advance. School uniform items are available at the Red Door.

Boy's Uniform: Navy blue dress pants (No jeans)
Short sleeved white knit shirt
Older boys get shirts with ribbed bottom at Red Door
Uniform school sweatshirt
Dress shoes (no sneakers)
Hair is to be kept cut above the collar – no lines – heads should not be completely shaved. No dyed or highlighted hair. No earrings.
Socks that come over the ankles (NO SPORTS SOCKS) Boys & Girls
Crew socks

Girl's Uniform (Grades 1-5): Plaid jumpers
Plaid Skorts
Short sleeved white knit shirt
Uniform school sweatshirt
Navy or plain white socks (SOCKS THAT COME OVER THE ANKLES)
Crew or knee socks Boys & Girls
Knee socks preferred
Dress shoes (no clogs, platform shoes or sneakers)
Only small earrings – No hoops
No makeup
No dyed or highlighted hair

Girl's Uniform (Grades 6-8): Plaid skirts
Short sleeved navy knit shirt
*If need to purchase new ones get shirts with ribbed bottom at the Red Door.
Uniform school sweatshirt
Knee socks
(NO SPORTS SOCKS) Boys & Girls socks over the ankle
Dress shoes (no clogs, platform shoes or sneakers)
Only small earrings. No hoops. No makeup.
No dyed or highlighted hair

GYM UNIFORMS:

In order to participate in Physical Education classes, uniform clothing, as specified below, must be worn. A medical or illness excuse preventing a child from participating in gym activity must be approved by the Principal.

Grades 1-4 Sneakers worn with school uniform (girls wear shorts under uniform)

Grades 5-8 Green gym shorts (available through the school), green or gold tee shirts, sneakers or any St. James School tee shirt (black, gray)
